General conditions:

The int. BAUAkademie ATUS Graz Trophy is organized by ATUS Graz and is open for all national and international teams/federations that are members of World Aquatics except RUS & BLR. The competition will be held under compliance of the rules of World Aquatics and the OSV. Prelims will be set according to the times submitted by the teams/federations. The submitted times must have been achieved within the last 18 months in a 50m pool. The organizers reserve the right to check those submitted times and if inconsistencies occur, those times will be replaced with NT. If a club/federation fails to submit entry times with their registration, the athletes will be placed under NT. The entry times for Austrian Clubs will be automatically selected from the system of the OSV. For teams from abroad please submit entry times that are documented in https://www.swimrankings.net/

Liability:

The organizer and other persons involved in the event are not liable for accidents, injuries or damage to a person or thing, whatever the cause. The legal guardian (parents) and the club are informed about health and other dangers and circumstances associated with the competition and expressly confirm with the registration that the participation in the event is at own risk and responsibility, and that no claims whatsoever are made against the organizer or other persons involved in the event. With the registration, the competition regulations, and organizational regulations, including any changes that may have become necessary, which have been published by e-mail at the latest two working days prior to the registration deadline, will be acknowledged.













Prize money:

The prize money will be rewarded to the 3 best placed women and men of the open class. For those rewards the best 3 individual performances of the afternoon finals sessions will be used and added in accordance with the current points system of World Aquatics.

Place €800. Place €500. Place €300.-

The prize money can only be given to the rewarded athletes in person and in cash. If one does not attend the ceremony at the end of Sundays final session the reward money will **not** be transferred, and it also cannot be given to another representative of the club/team.

Wednesday, 22nd of April 2026, from 17:00 - 20:00. A registration for the training session is **not** required.

The pooldeck will be accessible for teams from 4:30PM to 8:30PM.

Coaches meeting:

There will be a coaches-meeting on Wednesday April 22nd 2026 at 19:00 in the conference room on the 2nd floor. You're strongly encouraged to attend this meeting, as last changes/information will be discussed. An absence to this meeting is not an excuse for not knowing the proper procedures during warm-up and/or competition.

Penalty fees & refunds:

Please note that there will be absolutely no refunds of the entry fees if scratches are made after the scratching-deadline (which is equal to the entry deadline: 23:59 on April 14th, 2025) except for medical reasons, in this case we reserve the right to ask you to provide proof (note of a doctor etc.). Additionally, if an athlete misses his/her spot in the afternoons session (fastest heat or B/A-final) without scratching during the allowed scratching-period (usually 30mins after the event ended), there will be a penalty fee of 10x the amount of the entry fee (€ 120,--). This fee can either be paid directly at the meeting director in cash or it will be billed to you via E-Mail once the competition is over

For the 800m and 1500m Freestyle we require the following standard times to be swum at the event, a failure to meet those standards will be penalized with the 10x amount of the entry fee.

800m Freestyle: Women: 10:40,00

Men: 10:00,00

1500m Freestyle: Women: 20:00,00

Men: 18:45,00

Doping controls:

We would like to inform you that doping controls can be conducted during the meet and every athlete must be in accordance with the guidelines and rules of the NADA (National Anti-Doping Agency). In case your national Federation requires an anti-doping-control to approve a record or time standard reach out to organizer (christian.scheruebl@hotmail.com) in advance. We organize that tests can be performed in a timely manner. All costs are to be borne by the client.
