Final- Qualification

For the four 100m events, a combined ranking will be established; for student class 4, the ranking is based on the four 50m events. Points are calculated according to the current World Aquatics Short Course Table. The top five athletes per class qualify for the individual medley final. In the event of a tie in points, the best single performance determines the ranking.

Withdrawal deadline and cancellation fee

If the withdrawal deadline for the final (**15 minutes after event 25**) has passed and the athlete does not appear at the start or does not compete in the final, a cancellation fee of **€55** will be charged.

Joker-Rule:

If a swimmer is disqualified in one of the four 100m events (student class 1–3) or 50m events (student class 4), they are allowed to re-swim the event at the end of the third competition session. The World Aquatics points achieved in this re-swim are used solely for potential qualification for the final and have no impact on the individual event ranking.

A club representative must request the use of this rule from the announcer or event management immediately after the event in which the disqualification occurred. The heat will be scheduled by the organizer. In the case of a second disqualification or unsportsmanlike manipulation, the joker is forfeited.

Australian Final

The top five scorers in each student category (student class 1-3) qualify for the Australian Final, with rankings determined separately for girls and boys. The final consists of four consecutive heats in a "100m medley" format. Heats start every five minutes. After each heat, the last-placed competitor is eliminated, until the winner is determined in the final heat between the remaining two finalists. Competition begins with the youngest age group, with girls and boys starting in alternating order.

Entries:

By submitting entries, the participating clubs affirm that the swimmers they have entered can provide proof of their sports health, and the medical examination is not more than 12 months old as of the entry deadline.

Entry Deadline: 2nd October 2026, at 20:00 o'clock

Please note that the confirmation of receiving the entry is not the confirmation of participation! Submit the Lenex file to Martin Heger at events@msecm.at or make an online entry at www.msecm.at A maximum of 400 participants will be admitted. The order of receipt of the registrations will determine the acceptance.

Entry Fee: €6.00 per individual event

€7.50 per relay
